To be eligible for a Tuition Equalization Grant, a person must:

1. Be a qualified Texas resident;
2. Be enrolled full-time as a student in an approved independent college or university in Texas;
3. Maintain a 2.5 GPA
4. Establish financial need as defined by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board; and
5. Not be the recipient of any form of athletic scholarship.

+In 2005, the Texas Legislature created a TEG maximum grant for students from families with an EFC of \$1,000 or less. That maximum grant is equal to 150% of the TEG maximum for ordinary need.

Avg. TEG grant is calculated for regular needy students only

*\$600 cap on grants abolished

**In 2005-06, \$81,698,986 of the appropriation was used for TEG and \$24,275,669 for Texas Grant funds

** In 2006-07, \$86,874,655 of the appropriation was used for TEG and \$19,000,000 for TEXAS Grants Fund

**In 2007-08, \$99,882,011 of the appropriation was used for TEG and \$5,712,665 for TEXAS Grants Fund

**In 2008-09, \$102,540,655 of the appropriation was used for TEG \$3,334,000 for TEXAS Grants Fund

**In 2009-10, \$104,274,750 of the appropriation is allocated for TEG and \$1,600,000 for TEXAS Grant funds
